Additional Program Information:

1. All students accepted into the program are expected to follow the Haddonfield Public School's policy guidelines. (Students who are Haddonfield residents attending local private high schools are likewise expected to follow their school's policy guidelines.) If a majority of the selection committee finds that a student has committed a major policy violation (which calls into question the student's ability to behave appropriately and serve as a good example on the trip) the student will lose his/her right to go on the trip. If this happens all deposit monies will be forfeited unless a replacement is found.
2. In the event of any major infraction of school policies while on the trip, students may be sent home unescorted and at their own additional expense.
3. All students accepted into the program will be required to attend classes prior to the trip, beginning in the early part of 2008. The purpose of the classes will be to assist the students in understanding the basic culture and language of Japan, as well as for preparing some type of student presentation during their stay in Japan.
4. The anticipated cost of the trip is \$1,200-\$1,500 for the two-week stay. Students and chaperones will depart on July 11, 2008 and will be returning on July 25, 2008. Students are responsible for the entire cost.
